

Where Are Broadwater Sellers Going?

Many of the neighborhood sellers are downsizing, after enjoying many years in Broadwater. Many are moving to Manatee County, south of the Skyway Bridge, finding a home that's newer and less expensive. My son Rob can help you with that, as he lived there and knows the area well. Others are moving to a condo in downtown St Pete, to get a walkable lifestyle with lots and lots to do. I did this myself, so I can help you in that transition.

Others are moving further, to be closer to children and/or grandchildren. can help you with this, too, by connecting you with a knowledgeable agent in that area. We have connections with real estate professionals around the country, and around the globe. We'd be pleased to help you find one to trust with an out-of-town move. The hardest aspect of moving is usually leaving good friends and neighbors behind.

MARKET MUSINGS...

Compared to this time last year, there are the same number of active waterfront listings, four. Prices are a bit higher, ranging from \$605,000 to \$850,000 compared to last year's \$525,000 to \$822,500. There are three pending waterfront listings now, compared to four last year, ranging from \$715,000 to \$875,000. Last year's range was \$619,000 to \$995,000. Three non-waterfront listings are available this year, from \$435,000 to \$859,000. Last year there were none. This year one is under contract, listed at \$514,900 - last year there were three, from \$275,000-\$485,000.

Year to date 23 waterfront homes have sold, from \$490,000

to \$1,600,000. Last year 20 sold, from \$490,000 to \$810,000. 12 non-water-front homes have sold from \$210,000 to

\$535,000. Last year 11 sold, from \$220,000 to \$450,000.

If you determine the "hotness" of a waterfront neighborhood by the number of homes available versus sold year-to-date, Causeway Isles is the hottest with only 18%, followed by Venetian Isles with 25%, then Broadwater with 30%. The "coldest" is Pasadena Yacht & Country Clu at 144%.

If you lose or find a pet, we ask that you post a picture on Nextdoor Broadwater and provide as much detail as possible. If you are not on Nextdoor please report it to your Block Captain and email infolink@broadwaterfl.org. These methods have been very effective tools for reuniting pets with their owners.

Trash & Recycling Guidelines & Tools

By city ordinance, customers may place both trash and recycling containers at the curb after 7 PM the night before collection. Containers must be moved from the street and placed by the side or rear of the customer's residence **before 7 PM** the day of collection. Ever miss your scheduled pick-up due to a holiday? 
