

Boats in Boca Ciega Bay

We saw an increase in boats moored close to Broadwater in the Spring and brought it to the attention of City Council Rep Deborah Figg-Sanders. Deborah has hosted two meetings involving Broadwater, The Alliance of Bayway Communities (ABC), FWC, St Petersburg Police Marine Patrol and several state and county representatives. At the first meeting we discussed the risk of having so many boats so close to our neighborhood as well as the three grounded boats at the entrance to Clam Bayou. We found out that the process of removing these boats is very tedious and discussed ways to improve it. After the first meeting we saw an immediate impact as the St Petersburg Police Marine Patrol actively cited boats that were at risk or abandoned resulting in many of them relocating. We thank SPP Marine Patrol Officer Aron Franklin for his part in reducing the number of boats in close proximity!! At our second meeting we were informed that the three grounded boats were in process for removal and we are happy to report that one of them has been removed. We thank Council Member Figg-Sanders and ABC for their part in bringing this issue to the attention of City, County and State Representatives. We will continue to monitor Boca Ciega Bay and meet as needed to keep the bay navigable and Broadwater safer from runaway boats during storms.



Marina Walk Apartment Homes

An eight-story building is emerging in the Skyway Marina District and with a great location across from Maximo Marina, these luxury apartment homes with a western view figure to be the premier place to rent in the District in 2021. These one and two-bedroom luxury apartments will take advantage of views of downtown St. Petersburg, the Skyway Bridge and the sunsets of St. Pete Beach. Jack Dougherty was kind enough to show me around the site and experience the views. The apartments will have a 4-story parking garage on the SE side along 34th St S and there are plans for retail on the NE corner of the site. The first floor will have leasing offices along 46th Ave S and a café on the NW corner. On the NW corner of the 7th and 8th floors, there will be a Skylounge common area for all to enjoy the views! The 245 apartments will be one 1BR/1B (898 SF & 988 SF) and 2BR/2B (1103 SF). Rents are expected to run from \$1599 to \$2299 depending on size, floor level and premium views. MARKET MUSINGS

Inventory is low. Sales are hot! Right now there are only two active waterfront listings and five pending contracts. Average price of active listings is \$1,049,500. Average price of listings with pending contracts is \$854,780. Three of the five pending sales had zero days on the market. A year ago there were four active listings and two pendings, ranging from \$585,000 to \$749,000. Multiple offers are not uncommon.

There have been 15 waterfront sales so far this year, at an average price of \$757,800. Average days to

Some buyers add a connected half bath and a door directly to the outside from the home office. For those with children, study spaces are also important - and quiet for each student or worker.

TRASH & RECYCLING GUIDELINES & TOOLS

- By city ordinance, customers may place both trash and recycling containers at the curb as early as 7 PM the night before collection. Containers must be moved from the street and placed by the side or rear of the customer's residence by 7 PM the day of collection. Note: you can move a neighbor's trash can if they forget.
- Trash Collection for the week of Sept 7th will be Tuesday & Thursday
- Trash Collection for the week of Nov 22nd will be Monday & Wednesday, no change in Recycling

BROADWATER NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH



The only crimes to report lately is the crime of opportunity. Unlocked vehicles in Broadwater are a potential target at any time of the night or day. Keep your vehicles locked and your garage doors closed when unattended especially during the day. Be sure to let visitors and contractors know to lock their vehicles and do not leave valuables visible at any time. **Report <u>any</u> suspicious activity to the police** non-emergency (727-893-7780) and alert neighbors <u>right away</u> on Nextdoor. Notify your neighbors when you are out of town so they can contact you if they see sus-

picious activity. **Our best defense is neighbors looking out for each other**. One of the best ways to promote crime awareness and prevention is by participating in Neighborhood Crime Watch. We have a training class coming up and it is a great time for you to join the watch program. How do you volunteer? Contact me (see info below) and say you would like to be involved. Even if you are not able to patrol, our orientation will prepare you to be a more observant neighbor. If you are a former patroller that still has any patroller materials, please contact me so we can use them for new patrollers. If you see a neighborhood patroller, please take the time to wave and thank them for their efforts and always remember "Don't Feed the Bears"

Crime and Codes Report Monitoring Tool

Stat Map is an interactive tool that displays the locations of citizen requests submitted to the Mayor's Action Center and via SeeClickFix, as well the locations of code violations and police calls for service. This tool allows you to view the concerns people in and around your neighborhood have, create alerts for any new reports, and see changes over time. You can also highlight specific activity in council districts and neighbor-

hoods. Under Pins, you can see the trends in reports for Police Calls, Code Violations or SeeClickFix. Create an alert for a particular area by creating an account, typing an address or selecting an area. You can then decide how big you want to make your watch area. Stat Map will give you greater access to the information the city collects, while showing trends within our community. You can download Stat Map and view a tutorial at www.stpete.org/police


