MARKET MUSINGS ...

So far this year there have been six waterfront sales, averaging \$1,497,500, with a range of \$1,025,000 to \$2,000,000. **83% were cash sales.** They sold for an average of 93% of listing price and averaged \$735/sq ft, with a range of \$509/sq ft to \$984/sq ft. Average time to contract was 66 days, with a range of 0 to 186 days. As of August 15th there were five active waterfront listings, ranging from \$1,610,000 to \$2,998,000. There are no contracts pending.

The same period last year had eight sales averaging \$1,448,205 with a range of \$1,040,000 to \$3,111,143. 88% were cash sales. They sold for an average of 90% of list price. Days from listing to contract averaged 101 days and averaged \$598/sq ft.

This year there have been three non-waterfront sales, averaging \$601,333 with a range of \$280,000 to \$799,000. 67% were cash sales. Average time to contract was 55

days, with a range of 0 to 158 days. Average sale was 97% of list price. Average price per square foot was \$284 with a range of \$175to \$386/ sq ft.

The same period last year there were five sales. 60% were cash sales. Days from listing to contract averaged 101 days. Sale prices averaged 90% of last list price, 80% of original list price. As of August 15th there were 2 active listings, at \$775,000 and \$1,145,000. There were no contracts pending.

Save Our Homes cap, that your property taxes are based on. (It is less than the market value because average costs of sale are deducted - but the ratios are the same)

The Pinellas County Property Appraiser **www.pcpao.gov** issues these figures every August. If you disagree, you can contact the appraiser's office. If that is not straightened out, you can file an appeal before September 15, 2024.

In spot checking the Just Market Values (JMV) from the Pinellas Property Appraiser's office, most homes in Broadwater dropped in value from 1/1/23 to 1/1/24 by 5-6%. The range of those I checked ranged from -7.1% to +8.8%. A drop in JMV does not necessarily mean a drop in property taxes, depending on the accrued savings in Save Our Homes.

We have seen very little crime in Broadwater and that can attributed to prevention! Your awareness and vigilance is leaving no opportunity for thieves to take advantage of. BLOCK CAPTAINS

SHORT TERM RENTALS IN BROADWATER

For residential properties within the City of St. Petersburg, short-term rentals (durations of less than 30 days) may only be rented a maximum of three times within any consecutive 365-day period. Short-term rentals exceeding this allowance are a violation of city code. If you are having an issue with a short term rental, it is sometimes best to inform the owner of the code. If that doesn't work, contact the codes department, or submit via SeeClickFix or the Mayor's Action Line.

Stella and Nalo wanted to share some great information for dog owners in Broadwater. There are some great places to walk your



best friend in the Skyway Marina District! The Skyway Trail along 37th St S is a great place to meet other dogs and humans. You will find Marina Walk Dog Park and several area businesses that are dog friendly such as 5/3rd Bank, TD Bank, Pet Supermarket and Tiki Docks. Treats can be found at all four spots with Tiki Docks providing the ever popular Pup Cup!! Broadwater Park is another destination that provides large open areas and plenty of shade for you and your dog to explore. Clam Bayou Nature Preserve at the west end of 34th Ave S provides more shade and lots of areas to walk and sniff. Be sure to keep your dog on a leash and pick up after them and during the hot months bring water just in case. Sur Club has a large dog park that is open to the public and accessible from 32^{nd} Ave S east of 34th St S. After 5 PM there is some great shade cast by the building and you are sure to meet

CONCERNED ABOUT OUR WATERWAYS?

Early detection of red tide blooms allows researchers at FWC (Florida Fish & Wildlife Conservation Commission) to provide warning to coastal residents in the area, continue research, and predict seasonal events. We have community volunteers in our neighborhood to expand the spatial coverage of the FWC's monitoring program by collecting water samples from areas where red tide or any other water quality issue is suspected. Because of limited state personnel, boats and other limited resources, the program relies on volunteers to help monitor inshore bays and offshore coastal waters off the Gulf of Mexico.

Two water samples can be collected every couple of weeks in two different locations within our neighborhood. If you feel there is an indication of red tide or any other water quality issue, please text Mel Moss at 727-276-9345. Additional information can be found at www.broadwaterfl.org

Noise and Lights on the Water

Please be considerate of your neighbors while playing music outside if you live on the water. You would be surprised at how sound travels over water. Lighting can also be an issue for your neighbors on the water. Be sure to point your lighting away from the water to avoid causing an annoying reflection.


