In addition, because of insurance and hazardous waste disposal, we are unable to accept items on the list below. This includes items for children that are frequently recalled and could pose a danger.

Items Goodwill Can't Accept

- Automobile or truck parts
- Blinds or window treatments (unless in original packaging)
- Building materials
- Children's car seats, cribs or playpens
- Encyclopedias
- Food or food products
- Firearms and ammunition
- Furniture that cannot be sold as-is
- Grills
- Gas-powered items
- Hazardous materials i.e. oil, whiteout, Freon, gas, turpentine, paints, stains, propane, fuels, etc.
- Mattresses or box springs
- Outdoor children's toys i.e. swings, jungle gyms, slides etc.
- Sofa beds and sofas with recliners
- Televisions
- Washers and dryers
